

## SGE Subcontractor Assessment Policy

Silverstone Green Energy are committed to the health and safety of our own employees and of all those who may be affected by the work that we undertake. This is extended to all subcontractors which we employ to undertake work on our behalf. In order to achieve this we are committed to only engage with subcontractors who work competently and safely at all times.

All subcontractors employed by Silverstone Green Energy will be assessed prior to engagement to ensure the quality of the work to be carried out and the health and safety of all operatives and the general public. All subcontractors must be competent and experienced in the work they will undertake.

All subcontractors will be required to provide copies of relevant insurance certificates, covering the period for which they will be employed by Silverstone Green Energy.

All subcontractors will be required to provide details of the person(s) within the company who are responsible for their health and safety systems, and for providing professional advice.

Silverstone Green Energy will provide to all subcontractors details of our Risk Assessments for the sites where they will be employed, to aid in the production of their own Risk Assessments, and will ensure that information regarding health and safety matters is shared with all parties.

Silverstone Green Energy will provide all subcontractors with clear and detailed requirements for the work they will undertake.

Silverstone Green Energy will supervise all subcontractors both initially and periodically to ensure the competence of the operatives and quality of the work.

All subcontractors are required to report all health and safety and environmental incidents and near-misses to Silverstone Green Energy, at the earliest opportunity, providing full details of investigation and conclusions.

All subcontractor engagement will be reviewed periodically to ensure continuing compliance.
