
- Ensure all waste is collected, stored, segregated and disposed of safely and in accordance with statutory requirements and best practice.
- Monitor subcontractor compliance with statutory requirements.
- Ensure that records of waste consignments are kept in accordance with statutory requirements.
- Monitor the arrangements for the collection waste.
- Provide staff with suitable information, instruction and training to ensure that the waste management policy and procedures are understood and followed.
- Provide staff with appropriate personal protective clothing for handling waste.

SGE are committed to:

- Identify and minimise the risks associated with the various categories of waste by developing safe systems for the safe handling, containment and disposal.
- Arrange for the disposal of all waste products regularly, and in accordance with the relevant statutory requirements.

Future efforts should be in the first instance directed as minimising the volume of waste produced. Where waste is produced, SGE objectives should be to maximise the amount that is recycled and also to find less harmful alternatives where hazardous or difficult to dispose of products are used.
